Bromont, June 21th, 2010 – The best Canadian and American drivers will meet at the Bromont International Driving for an exciting competition held at the Bromont Olympic Equestrian Park on June 25th, 26th and 27th.

The Bromont International Driving will celebrate its ninth edition with a new record: the last weekend in June, for the first time at this competition, no less than 8 FEI level driving teams of 4 horses will be competing.

Quebec driver, Eugen Hug, a native of the Eastern Townships, will face off with the Canadian and American elite in the events of this ninth edition of the Bromont International Driving; Chester Weber, Casey Zubek, Wendy Ying, Josh Rector and David Saunders of the USA as well as Canadians Deb Laderoute and Darryl Billing have already confirmed their participation.

Well schooled? Bromont is the place to go!

This year is the perfect time to come to Bromont as many divisions of the International Driving have been selected by the FEI as qualifying events for the 2010 World Equestrian Games, to be held in Kentucky.

Also, close to seventy drivers will compete in the three driving disciplines: dressage, marathon and obstacle driving. Don't miss this event demonstrating the drivers' ability combined with the horses' graceful stride.

The International Driving Bromont, the most important horseshow in Canada and the second in North America, is a « FEI / CAI-A » classified event; meaning that the points riders earn are recognized and compiled for world standing. Every year, participants and their horses show off their dexterity on the picturesque Olympic Equestrian Park.

Created for the 1976 Montreal Olympic Games, the Bromont Olympic Equestrian Park is one of the only sites in the world having kept its initial vocation once the Olympics are over. The Equestrian Park is host to numerous competitions such as the International Bromont, the International Driving and the Quebec Equestrian Games.
